- **Education**

ODS held a symposium in April with Lee Tubman titled “The Judge’s Perspective: Training for Riding a Dressage Test” On Saturday, Mr. Tubman explained to the auditors why he has recommended certain riding techniques and improvements while applying classical dressage training and explaining in how riders receive their marks. Answering the questions what/why/how. On Sunday: 30 minute sessions—each rider riding a dressage test of their choosing. After



judging the test, the clinician critiqued the test for the rider and audience; thereafter, working through a few movements to improve the scores. In the fall of 2015, Great Plains hosted "Judge with the Judge" continuing education course with Debbie Riehl-Rodriquez. ODS's summer meeting for this year will be held at in Oklahoma City. Laurie McDonald will speak on saddle fitting and TD Susan Lang on bits. Both will include western saddles and bits.

- **Philanthropy**

ODS will donate a basket to the Great American/USDF Region 9 and Southwest Dressage Championships. ODS does give scholarships. They also donate an item or basket to the Region 9 Summer Meeting

- **Horse Shows**

ODS held a two day recognized show at the Tulsa Expo Fairgrounds. Our show committee focused on making our show a 'grand event' and succeeded handsomely. They have held silent auctions and provided VIP seating areas. They have found a large variety of sponsors and vendors. There was a derby party prior to the evening awards and musical freestyles. ODS this year had a waiting list. ODS raised approximately \$10,000, which will be used towards funding more expensive facilities and prize money. Susan Peacock donated her secretarial services in honor of her mother. There is a beautiful annual Bee Pape award given to the highest scoring junior/young rider at Saturday's show.
